

# P320 Owner Action Checklist

Verify your upgrade status, document it, and carry with confidence.

## Step 1: Verify Your Upgrade Status

- Locate the serial number on your P320 (right side of the slide or frame).
- Go to Sig Sauer's official P320 Voluntary Upgrade Program page.
- Enter your serial number and note the result below.
- If you own more than one P320, repeat for each pistol separately.

## Step 2: If Not Upgraded, Enroll

- Submit your serial number through Sig's enrollment form.
- Confirm you received a case number or shipping instructions by email.
- Ship the pistol per Sig's instructions (Sig covers shipping both ways).
- Expect a turnaround of roughly four to six weeks.

## Step 3: Document Everything

- Save a screenshot or PDF of your serial number lookup result.
- Save any confirmation emails from Sig Sauer, including case numbers.
- Keep the shipping receipt if you send the pistol in for upgrade.
- Store this checklist and all records together in one folder.

## Step 4: Carry Setup Check

- Confirm your holster provides full trigger guard coverage.
- Confirm your holster is fitted to your exact P320 slide and frame combination.
- Re-check retention and fit if you've swapped grip modules or slides.

## Step 5: Stay Informed

- Bookmark GunCarrier's ongoing P320 litigation coverage.
- Revisit this checklist if new case rulings or Sig statements are issued.
- If your P320 ever discharges without a trigger pull, preserve the firearm exactly as-is and consult an attorney before cleaning, modifying, or returning it.
