
Pre-Purchase Reliability Checklist

Run any carry gun through these five checks before you trust it for daily use. Print this, take it to the range, and check off each box as you complete it.

1. ROUND-COUNT TESTING

- ☐ Fired at least 200 rounds of the exact ammo you plan to carry, not just range-day FMJ.
- ☐ Tested a minimum of two ammo types (practice FMJ and your actual carry hollow point).
- ☐ Zero malfunctions across every testing session logged so far.
- ☐ Started a dated, written round-count log for this specific gun.

2. FIT AND DRAWSTROKE

- ☐ Tested the drawstroke from the exact holster you plan to carry daily.
- ☐ Tested the drawstroke from your actual carry position (appendix, strong-side, etc).
- ☐ Confirmed a consistent, snag-free draw across multiple range sessions.
- ☐ Confirmed the grip size and trigger reach fit your hand comfortably.

3. KNOWN ISSUES CHECK

- ☐ Checked the manufacturer's official spec page for current production details.
- ☐ Confirmed there are no open recalls or safety notices for this model or serial range.
- ☐ Asked the dealer directly about the gun's production date before buying.

4. COMPARISON AND BUDGET

- ☐ Compared this gun against at least one real alternative, not just the one you already want.
- ☐ Verified current street pricing with a licensed dealer, not an old online listing.
- ☐ Confirmed magazine, holster, and optic compatibility and their added cost.

5. DOCUMENTATION

- ☐ Photographed or saved the purchase receipt and serial number.
- ☐ Logged the first range session date, ammo used, and round count.
- ☐ Set a recurring reminder to update the round-count log going forward.
